Flexible reporting and seamless change automation

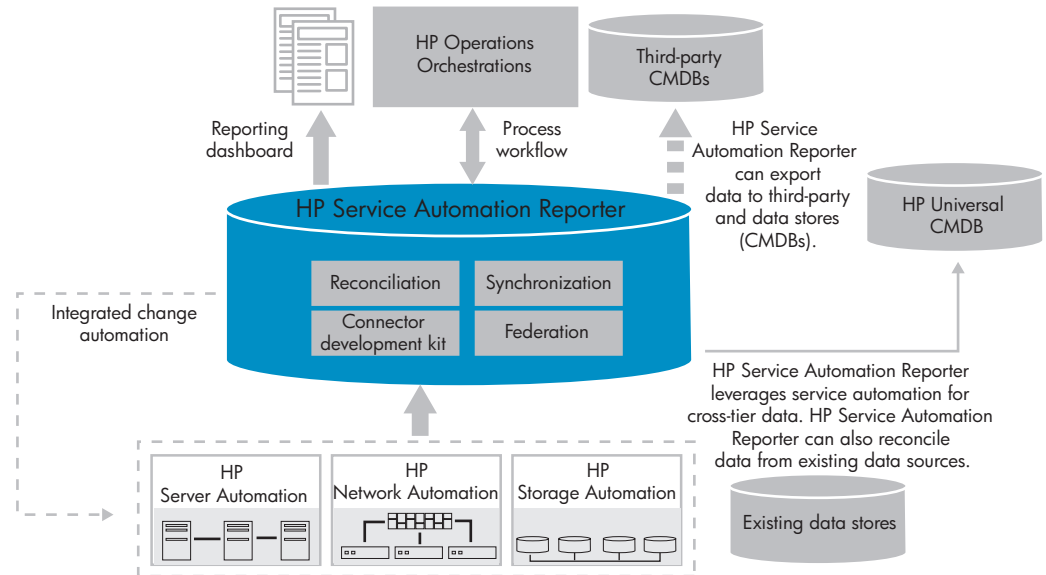

Leveraging HP Data Center Automation Center software, including HP Network Automation software, HP Server Automation software and HP Storage Automation software, HP Service Automation Reporter automatically populates and maintains all of your infrastructure configuration items (CIs), their detailed attributes and their inter-dependencies. Once populated, you can make changes to configure or remediate your IT infrastructure with a single click. HP Service Automation Reporter records all operational data associated with the change information, allowing you to quickly audit your IT infrastructure.

HP Service Automation Reporter also offers open bi-directional interfaces to easily integrate its data with existing databases as well as ecosystem applications and processes.

HP Service Automation Reporter acts as a repository for cross-tier IT data and can reconcile data across existing data sources. HP Service Automation Reporter can also export data to third-party applications, processes and data stores.

Automatically populate your CMDB with complete cross-tier infrastructure and operational data.

A configuration management database (CMDB) is the key infrastructure data store in ITIL. Without accurate and comprehensive CMDB data, ITIL implementations will fail. In today's complex IT environment, manually populating a CMDB is expensive, time intensive and difficult to maintain. Individually integrating siloed data from disparate tools also produces an incomplete database.

HP Service Automation Reporter automates the process of discovering and accurately maintaining your cross-tier IT infrastructure, including software applications, servers, networks and storage devices, across your enterprise and populates your CMDB with data. HP Service Automation Reporter also automatically and proactively records operational changes in your environment. For example, HP Service Automation Reporter not only tracks changes to a router, but it tracks who made a change, when it was made and whether the change was approved. By providing a comprehensive and accurate operational repository, HP Service Automation Reporter helps you implement ITIL processes successfully across your entire organization.

Improve the intelligence of your IT infrastructure data.

HP Service Automation Reporter ships with several pre-defined reports that quickly address enterprise ITIL and compliance requirements, including Sarbanes-Oxley (SOX) and Control Objectives for Information and related Technology (COBIT). It provides a rich analytic framework to create ad hoc, structured or historical trend analysis reports. HP Service Automation Reporter also provides intuitive interfaces so you can search and drill down into CI data efficiently from across your enterprise.

Get closed-loop change process management.

Effective change management is critical for ITIL and CMDB implementations. HP Service Automation Reporter is integrated with HP Operations Orchestration, which provides flexible change process workflows and connectors to many IT management applications, such as service desk and monitoring systems. HP Operations Orchestration includes more than 2000 pre-built workflows, flow templates and operations for common data center environments. With out-of-the-box integration, you can automate standard change processes, such as end-to-end compliance and remediation, for efficiency, accuracy and repeatability of your processes.
