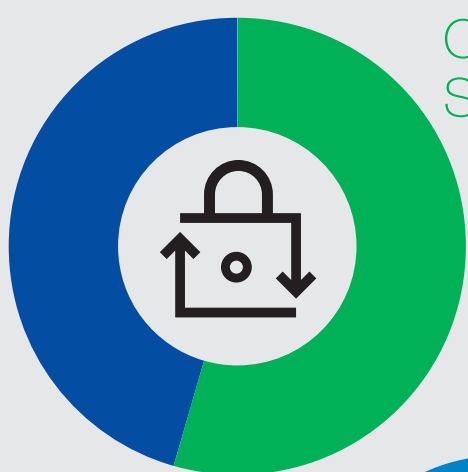




The State of Federal Mobile Security

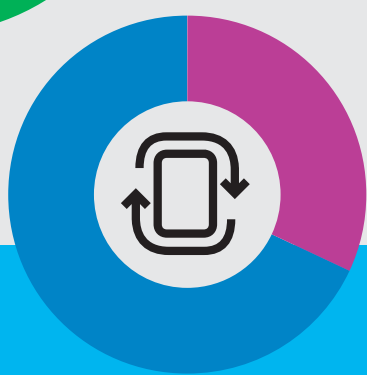

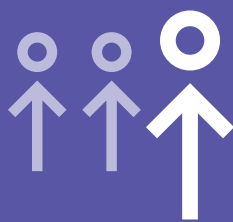
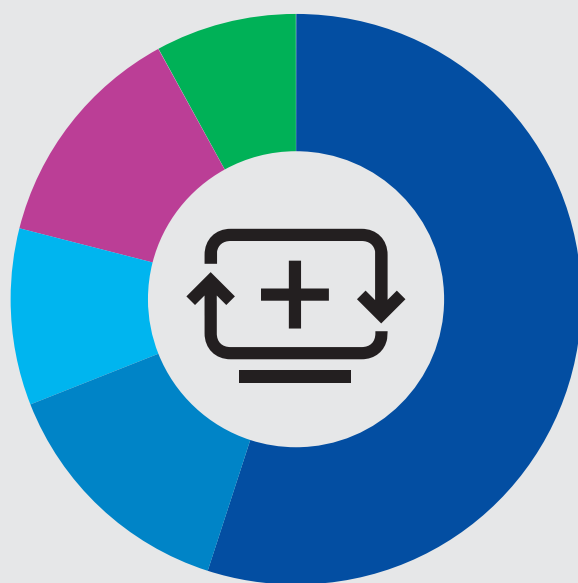
