

QlikWorld Tour 2022 Virtual Event

Registration and Attendance Terms & Conditions

Registration; Eligibility Confirmation; Substitutions. Registration for QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event (the “Event”), to be held virtually from May 17 through May 19, 2022, may only be completed online. By registering for the QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event, you agree to these terms and conditions of attendance and all supplemental documents and policies related to the Event and you acknowledge that you are over age 18 and are not barred from attending the Event under any applicable laws in your country of residence. Upon completing your registration, you will receive a confirmation email and further communications regarding the Event. No substitutions of attendees is permitted; each attendee must separately register for QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event.

Event Credentials; Changes. Login in credentials will be provided by Qlik prior to the Event. It is prohibited to provide or share your login credentials to any other person. Qlik, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to change any and all aspects of QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event, including but not limited to amending, rescheduling or canceling sessions or events at QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event at any time without any notice.

Event Profile; Event Chat. Each attendee is required to set up Event profile, which contains your name, company name and email address. The Event platform permits attendee profile information to be viewed and downloaded by other attendees and Event sponsors, and has a chat feature enabled. If you do not want your profile details to be visible (other than user name), you may change your profile settings on the Event platform by selecting ‘My Profile’ in the left- hand navigation. Attendees may further restrict whether other attendees may download their contact information and may turn off the chat functionality within the Event Platform. Event Game. During the Event, all attendees will be automatically enrolled in the QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event Scavenger Hunt to earn points by participating in activities during the Event. Rules for the QlikWorld Tour Virtual Event Scavenger Hunt will be available on the Event platform on the left-hand navigation, and attendees will be able to review the list of eligible activities at the start of the Event. All attendees will be able view their own points throughout the Event in a ‘My Points’ section and a leaderboard listing attendees’ usernames will be available throughout the Event.
