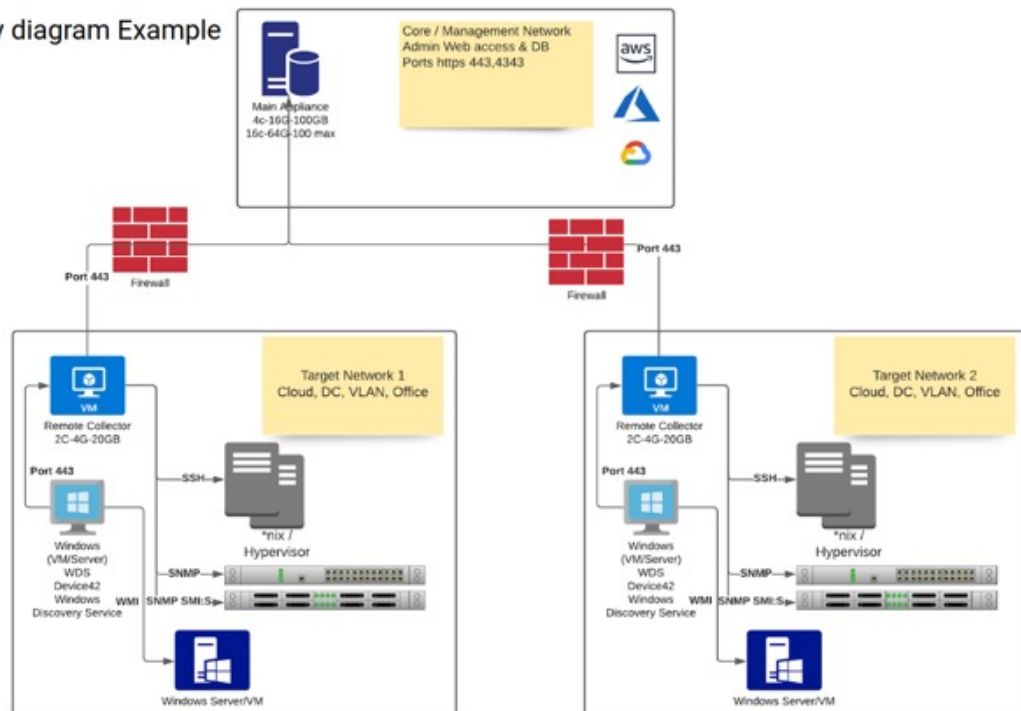

## Mandatory Pre-Deployment Requirements

### Define Your Installation Layout

## Install Main Appliance (MA)

The Main Appliance (MA) can be on-premises or on your own hypervisor.

## **Deploy Windows Discovery Service (WDS)**

The next step needed if you would like to discover Windows Servers is to deploy a Windows Discovery Service (WDS). This is a .NET Installer for any Windows machine you have available that can reach one of the Remote Collectors (RC).

### Service Account Credentials

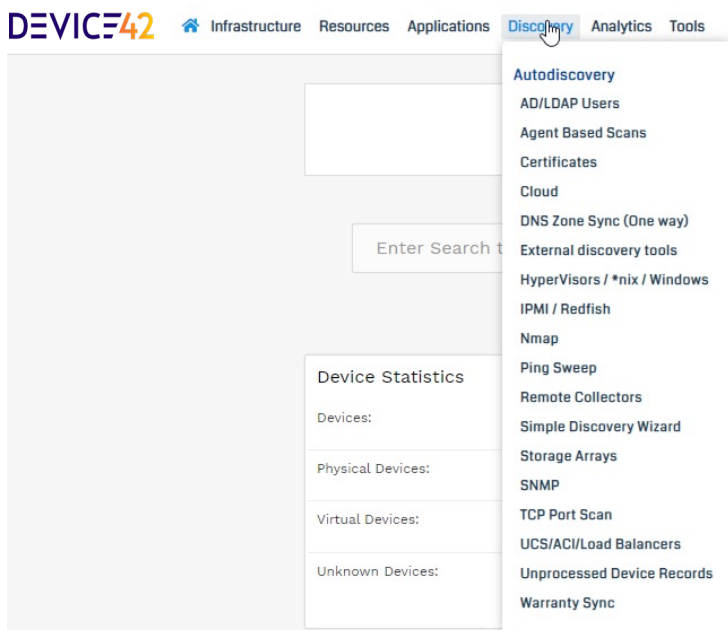
Under "Resources" -> "All Secrets" you will find the area to create your service account credentials.
